GALAPAGOS ENTRY REQUIREMENTS UPDATE (by plane)

(Quito, Pichincha). - Ecuadorian Authorities introduced the following entry requirements for Galapagos, by air, which will take effect from **September 11th at 00h00.**

ENTRY TO GALAPAGOS:

All passengers, older than 2 years old, regardless of their residence, must **present a negative result of a COVID-19 RT-PCR test, taken within a maximum up to 72 hours prior to boarding their flight,** whether or not they are fully vaccinated against COVID-19.

Please note that that all passengers must present the Traffic Control Card issued by the Government Council.

ENTRY TO ECUADOR:

The entry requirements have not changed since the update on the 15th July.

They are:

- All passengers over 2 years old must present a **negative result of an COVID-19 RT-PCR test, performed up to 72 hours prior to boarding the flight,**
or
- **A complete COVID-19 vaccination certificate,** with the last dose administered at least 14 days prior to travel.

Everybody entering mainland Ecuador by international air must submit the **Traveller's Health Declaration,** which can be downloaded at the following link: <https://bit.ly/3mka9tl>

Please remember that requirements may vary according to the evolution of the epidemiologic situation. Please check requirements before your journey.
